VENDOR BOOTH GUIDELINE

- ◆ You must present, along with your application, a certificate of liability insurance (or sign a hold-harmless waiver agreement provided by the ROC Recovery Center).
- ◆ Information Booth Sizes are 10 x 10 - If you need additional space you will need to contact Director Doug Gould at (541-200-3000 or rocrecoverycenter@gmail.com)
- ◆ **Information Booth set up and placement will be on Saturday Sept. 5th 8am to 9am – (Early Set Up is OK) We will be setting up along both sides on the main entrance to the center pavilion area.**
- ◆ Lithia Field is located at 300 Lowry Lane, Medford, OR.
- ◆ **Booths must be staffed and operational by 9:00am on Saturday September 5th. (Please use Canopy Weights to secure your booth, NO TENT STAKES)**
- ◆ **Information Booths cannot be dismantled no earlier than 3:00pm on Saturday. (You can stay for the entire day)**
- ◆ Join us for the “**GUNS VS HOSES VII**” which begins at 1:30pm prior to the “**Recovery All-Stars**” **Championship Softball Tournament @ 6PM.**
- ◆ Information Booth locations will be marked; all vendors will be notified of their placement via e-mail correspondence one week prior to the festival.

In consideration of being allowed to participate in the **2026 Strong & Courageous Recovery Festival**, including but not limited to the **ROC the Recovery Softball Tournament, Guns & Hoses Charity Game, “Drop the ROC” 3K/5K Walk, Jog, Run for Recovery** and all other associated games, activities, and events (collectively “Activity”), I, on behalf of myself and my heirs, next of kin, and representatives, agree to the following:

I hereby release from all liability and promise not to sue the ROC Recovery Center, Festival Sponsors, Festival Vendors, Medford Parks & Recreation Department, and their respective officers, directors, staff, volunteers, and agents (collectively “Released Parties”) for any and all claims, including those arising from negligence, that may result in personal injury (including paralysis or death), illness, property damage, emotional distress, or other loss arising from my participation in this Activity, including travel to and from the event.
